

Minutes of the meeting held on 12TH January, 2017 in Hon. High Court's PIL 176/2012

As per the direction given by Hon. High Court in PI 176/2012, the committee under the chairmanship of Divisional Commissioner Nashik is constituted to review the progress made by various agencies in tackling issues related to pollution of Godavari River.

The points discussed in the meeting are as following:

1)Nashik Municipal Corporation: Collection of solid waste along the banks of Godavari river, they must keep two separate dust bins one for Nirmalaya and another for (domestic) solid waste.

The waste such as plastic bags, flowers, Nirmalaya etc. should be collected twice a day once at 11.00 am and next at 9.00 pm. Water hyacinth should be removed removed on regular basis with additional man power.

2)Nashik Municipal Corporation (NMC) to complete construction broken chambers of the sewer line along the Godavari river which are damaged by the flood. Nashik Municipal Corporation should also construct boulders/barricades along the river to prevent the residents from washing vehicles, clothes etc.

3)MIDC to get sanction the DPR of CETP to be constructed in Ambad MIDC.

4)Land acquisition officer to expedite the acquisition procedure for Pimpalgaon STP.

5)Collector Nashik to get the thematic maps of Godavari river for aquifer mapping as recommended by NEERI.

6) Police department should keep close watch on the people washing vehicles and clothes and do more cases u/s 108,117 of Bombay police Act and also under 188 of Indian Penal Code.

All the departments (Nashik Municipal Corporation, Police department, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board and Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation) should comply on the report of NEERI which is submitted in December, 2016.
