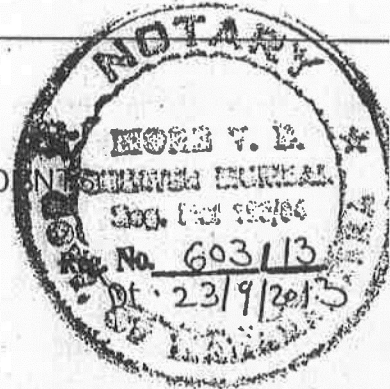

ADDITIONAL AFFIDAVIT



I, Ankush Sopanrao Fulse, Aged about 57 years, Occupation :  
Service, the Regional Officer of the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board  
at Nashik, having my office at 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Udyog Bhavan, Opp. ITI Satpur,  
Nashik, do hereby state on solemn affirmation as under:-

I say that I am filing this Affidavit with a limited purpose and for  
bringing on record the steps taken by the Respondent No.3 in compliance  
of the order dtd.20/8/2013 passed by this Hon'ble Court, which is as  
follows.

(1) Steps taken in respect of the Nashik Municipal Corporation :

- (i) The Respondent Board has granted Consent to the  
Nashik Municipal Corporation vide consent dated 30/7/2013

subject to certain terms & conditions mentioned therein as under:

The Board has stipulated stringent standards for discharge of treated effluent after achieving the following standards for the important parameters, as under :

1.	B.O.D. (5 days 20°C)	Not to exceed 30.00 mg/l.	Not to exceed 10 mg/l.
2.	Oil & Grease	Not to exceed 10.00 mg/l.	Not to exceed 5 mg/l.
3.	Dissolved Oxygen	No standards given	Not less than 5 mg/l
4.	Bioassay test on fish	No standard given	90% survival of fish after first 96 hrs. in 100% effluent.

Copies of the earlier consent dtd.29/09/1994 alongwith its renewal upto 31/12/2003 and the present consent dtd.30/7/2013 are enclosed herewith and marked as an **Exhibit-'A' & 'B'** respectively.

- (ii) I say and submit that the officers of the Respondent Board at Nashik prepared point-wise compliance report with reference to the directions issued by the Member Secretary, MPCB to the Respondent No.2. A copy of the pointwise status of compliance of various conditions imposed in the directions issued by the Member Secretary of the Respondent Board dtd.12/3/2013 communicated by the I/c Sub-Regional Officer of the Board at Nashik and Regional Officer, MPCB, Nashik dtd.31/07/2013 is enclosed herewith and marked as an **Exhibit-'C'**.

(2) **Monitoring of Godavari River catchment area:**

- (i) I say and submit that the Respondent No.3 through its offices at Nashik regularly monitors the catchment area of Godavari River at various points along with outlet quality of sewage treatment plant. A statement showing the river quality on the basis of monitoring done at various points for the period of last one year in comparison with the standards prescribed for the designated use of the river i.e. 'A-II' Class of river Godavari along with sewage treatment plant inlet and outlet is enclosed herewith and marked as Exhibit-'D' and Exhibit-'E' respectively.

After perusing the results, the quality of the river water with respect to parameters like pH, D.O. & BOD, it is observed that upstream of Nashik, the river water quality conforms to A-II Class quality. Whereas, BOD & D.O. of water quality in Nashik & downstream of Nashik for few samples are marginally not meeting the prescribed standards.

- (3) **Rapid Survey carried out by the Respondent No.3 for MIDC Satpur area:** - I say and submit that the Respondent no.3 is regularly monitoring compliance of the consent conditions of industries. The frequency of visit to these industries is based on category and scale of industries. The Red category and large scale industries are monitored monthly. Other industries are monitored quarterly, half yearly and yearly as per category and scale. Samples of air and effluent is collected during the visits. If the analysis results of the industry exceeds the prescribed standards, the Respondent Board takes necessary corrective / punitive action against the

I further say and submit that the Respondent Board has constituted a committee comprising of 3 Field Officers. The said officers have carried out rapid survey of the industries situated in MIDC Satpur, Nashik. The details are as under :

- i) Total no. of industries - 485
  - (a) Red Category :- 79
  - (b) Orange Category :- 25
  - (c) Green Category :- 381
- ii) Industries generating effluent :- 65
- iii) Industries having adequate ETP:- 58

I say and submit that the Satpur industrial area is located near Godavari river. Nasardi River passes between Ambad MIDC and Godavari River. Nasardi River finally meets Godavari river downstream of Nashik city. Hence Reapondent Board has carried out rapid survey for MIDC Satpur area initially, similar rapid survey for MIDC Ambad area is proposed to be carried out shortly.

(4) **Action taken against defaulting industries:-**

I say and submit that the Respondent no.3 has taken appropriate action against defaulting industries considering the nature of default under various Environmental Enactments. Summary of action taken is as below:

- (i) Action taken against defaulting industries for not obtaining consent from the Board by issuing voluntary closure direction under Section 33A of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and under Section 31A of the



List of industries to whom voluntary closure directions are issued is enclosed herewith and marked as **Exhibit-'F'**


- (ii) Action taken against defaulting industries for non-compliance of consent conditions obtained from the Board by issuing proposed directions under Section 33A of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and under Section 31A of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981: **11 No's.** A List of industries to whom proposed directions are issued is enclosed herewith and marked as **Exhibit-'G'**

- (iii) Action taken against defaulting industries for not achieving discharge standards as per consent conditions obtained from the Board by issuing show cause notice: **6 No's.** A list of industries to whom proposed directions are issued is enclosed herewith and marked as **Exhibit-'H'**

- (5) I say and submit that the Respondent Board has communicated to the Chief Engineer, MIDC Pune vide letter dated 15/07/2010 for allocation of plot and to provide CETP. I say and submit that the Respondent No. 3 has issued Directions under Section 33A of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 to provide CETP for Ambad and Satpur MIDC industrial area. Copy of the letter dated 21/09/2013 is enclosed herewith and marked as **Exhibit – 'I'**.

- (5) **Awareness Campaign taken by the Respondent No.3** :- The following steps/measures are taken by the Respondent No.3

- (i) The Respondent No.3 further celebrate '**The World Environment Day**' and '**The Ozone Day**' every year,



Associations/s, Local Self Government Representatives and Govt. officials from other Departments alongwith public at-large is ensured. The Respondent Board conducts Cycle Rally in Nashik City to create an awareness about environment protection every year with help & assistance of other Organisation in Nashik.

- (ii) Besides above awareness programs, the Respondent Board with the assistance from the industries, conducts live road shows (Pathnatya). More than 25 such programs organized at different places.
- (iii) The Respondent-Board also spends considerable amount on public advertising through Audio-Visual, TV, Radio and also issued various publications in respect of celebration of eco-friendly Holi, Diwali, Ganeshostav and Durgashtami etc. The Respondent Board promoted the concept of eco friendly idols & decorations, more particularly in celebration of Ganneshostva.
- (iv) The Respondent-Board has also started the 'Vasundhara' Award to encourage the organization/s complying with the Environmental Norms and to promote further improvement in existing pollution control measures taken by the industries .
- (v) The Board is also in the process of preparation of awareness programme for Godavari River Protection and Separate funds are being earmarked for the same.

(6) I, therefore say and submit that the Respondent No.3 is trying its level best to take steps not only to monitor the subject matter of the

petition but also to ensure that the surrounding area of Godavari River is protected and taken necessary actions against polluters.

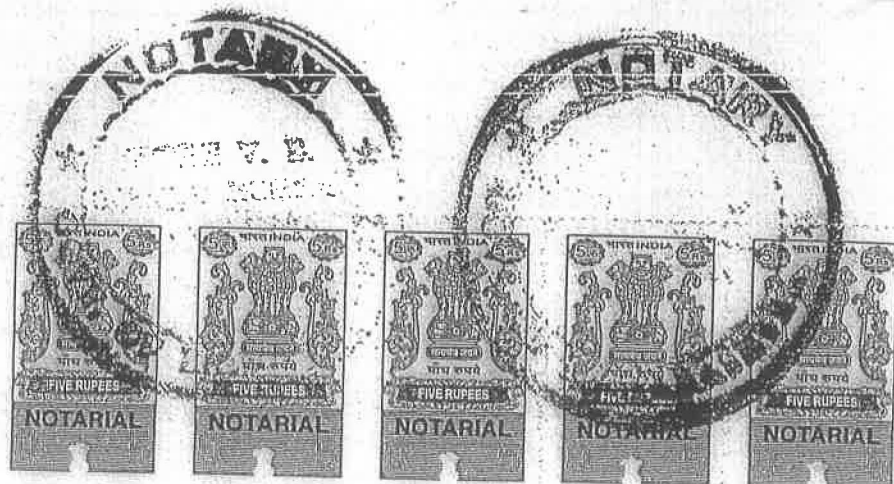

2. Preliminary report submitted by NEERI before the Hon'ble High Court  
3. Order dtd.20/8/2013 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of judicature at Mumbai in the Public Interest Litigation No. 176/ 2012.

WHEREAS, the Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation is the nodal agency for providing infrastructure facilities for the MIDC area and also to ensure that the industries situated in the MIDC area should have been provided with proper water supply, roads, drainage lines including proper collection and sewerage line as well as treatment and disposal system to the waste water generated from their activities.

AND WHEREAS, the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board had taken due persuasion for setting up CETP of the adequate capacity for the treatment and disposal of the waste water generated from the MIDC Ambad and Satpur area.

AND WHEREAS, the Regional Officer, Nashik has issued a letter dated 15/7/2010 to MIDC, requesting to take steps towards establishment of CETP for Satpur & Ambad MIDC area.

AND WHEREAS, one Public Interest Litigation bearing No.176/2012 is filed by Rajesh Pandit against the Nashik Municipal Corporation and Ors., wherein the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Mumbai has directed NEERI to submit Preliminary Assessment Report in respect of Studies on Rejuvenation of River Godavari and Integrated Action Plan for improvement of environment status for Nashik region.

AND WHEREAS, NEERI has submitted its Preliminary Report dtd.6/5/2013, wherein, the NEERI has recommended that MIDC should construct Common Effluent Treatment Plant in MIDC Ambad & Satpur Areas of Nashik for water polluting industries and its performance should be regularly monitored.



NOW THEREFORE, in compliance of the order dated 20/8/2013 passed by the Hon'ble High Court , Mumbai in the above matter, you are hereby directed to comply with the following conditions :-

- a) You shall quantify the effluent generation from the trade as well as domestic from the industries situated in MIDC Ambad & Satpur Area of Nashik within a period of 2 months.
- b) You shall allot a suitable plot for setting up CETP for Ambad & Satpur Area.
- c) You shall plan proper pipeline / drainage network to collect and transport the effluent from industries from Ambad & Satpur MIDC to the allotted plot for CETP within 6 months period.
- d) You shall co-ordinate with the Industrial Associations in Ambad & Satpur MIDC and formulate a time bound plan to set up CETP within a period of one year.
- e) You shall furnish an irrevocable bank guarantee of Rs.25 Lakhs, ensuring the compliance of above conditions, which shall be valid for a period of one year within a period of 15 days in favour of Regional Officer, MPCB, Nashik, so as to ensure the concrete steps for providing CETP in the above area, in order to protect the nearby environment.

You are, therefore, directed to secure the compliance of the above conditions and submit an Action Taken Report to the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board fortnightly.
